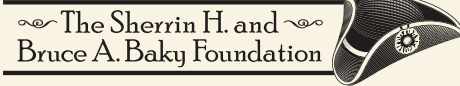
TURNING THE TIDES OF WAR: FRENCH ALLIANCE DAY
