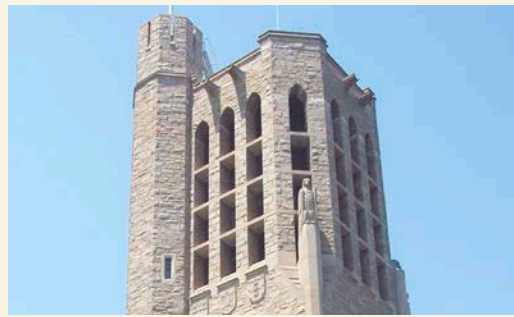
JULY 4th COMMUNITY PICNIC IN THE PARK
